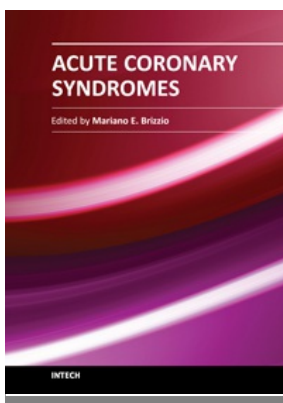

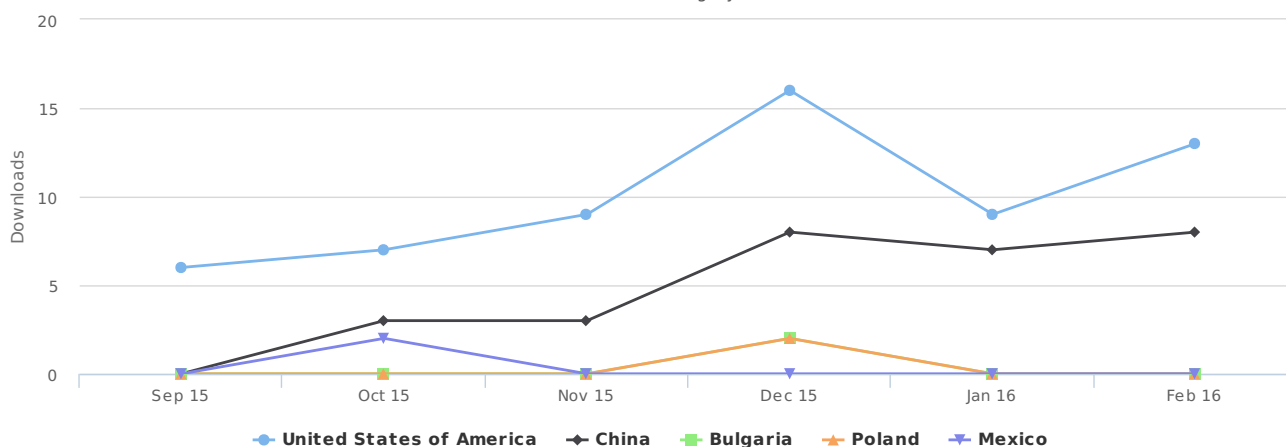

Cumulative Downloads By Countries/Time Frame (Total: 2000)

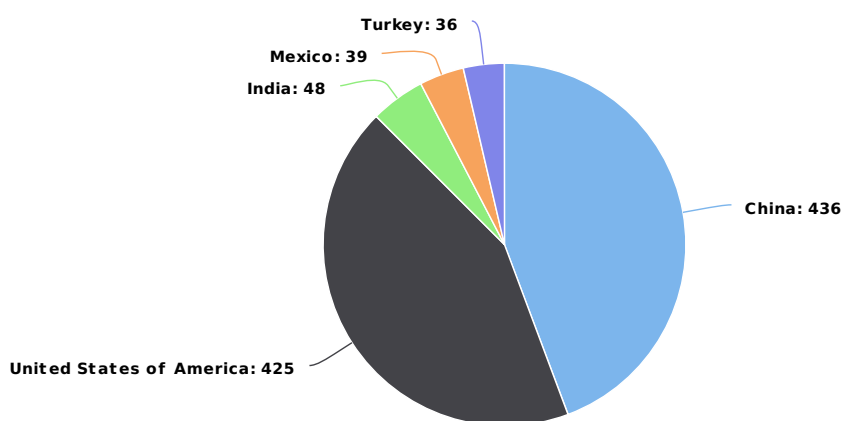

Cumulative Downloads By Countries (Total: 2000)

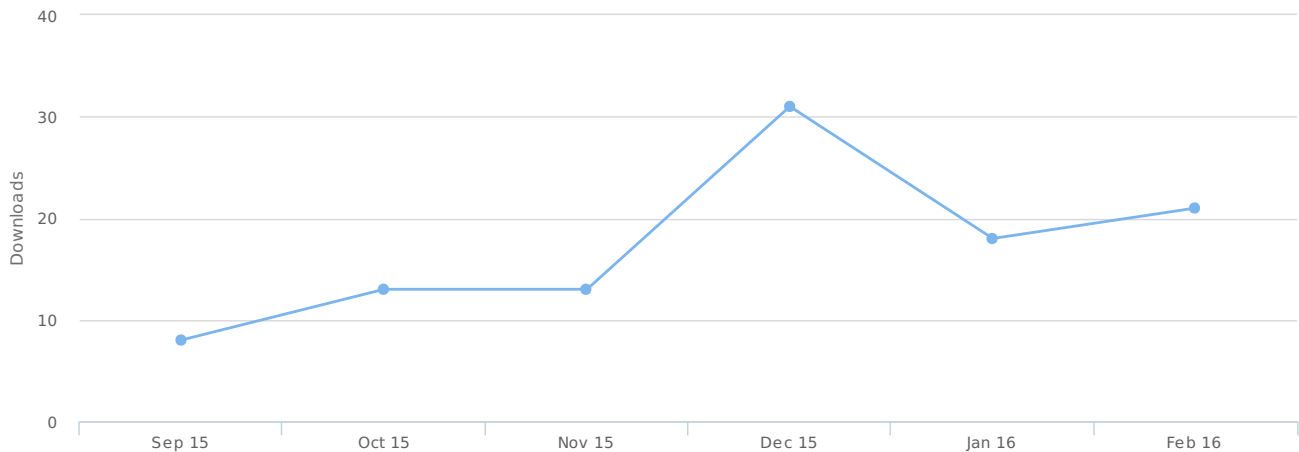
